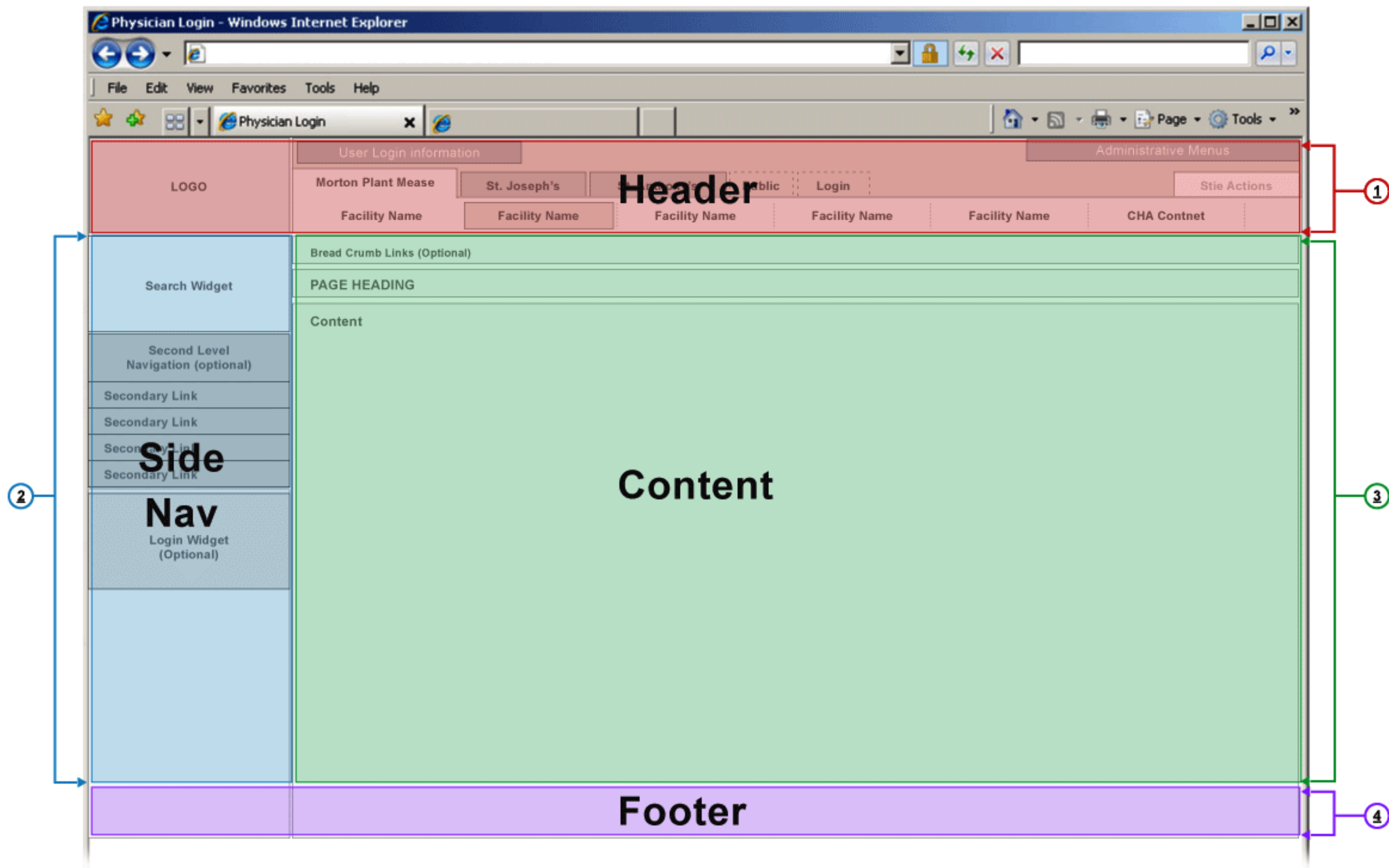

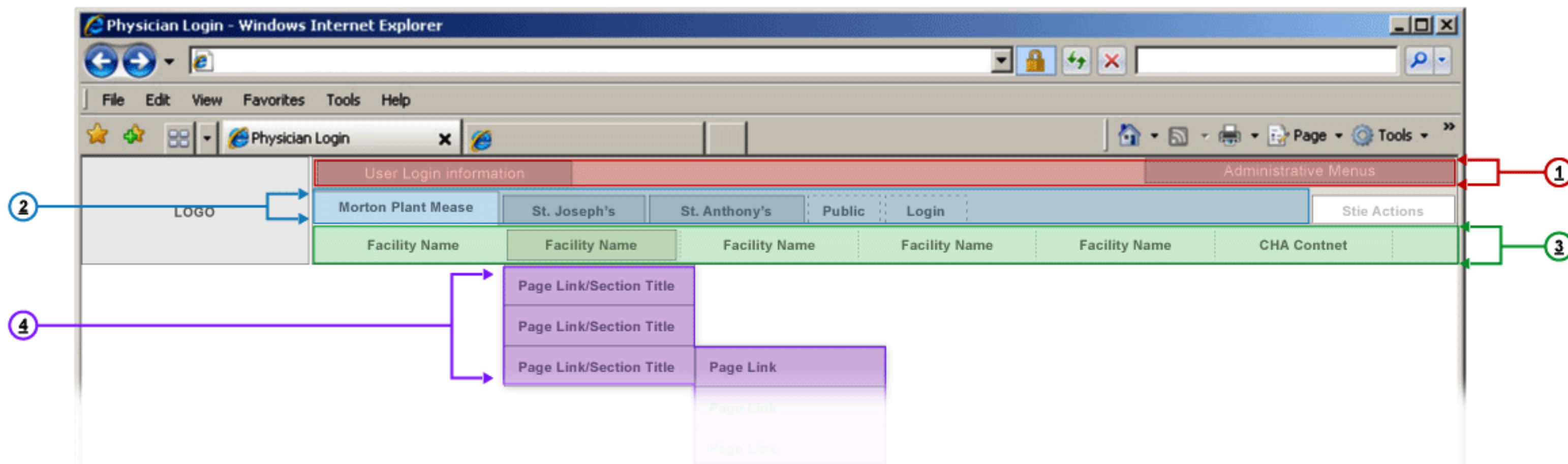

(CHA must visually contain First level/Facilities links). These link tabs will contain CHA selection as well as any public (non-register user) info, an or register (logged in, registered user) info. Two tabs are displayed to represent the separation of content. This can be changed if desired.

- Background color/image

3 First/Facility Level Links

Administrative and login information not related to content.

Style For On, Off and Hover.

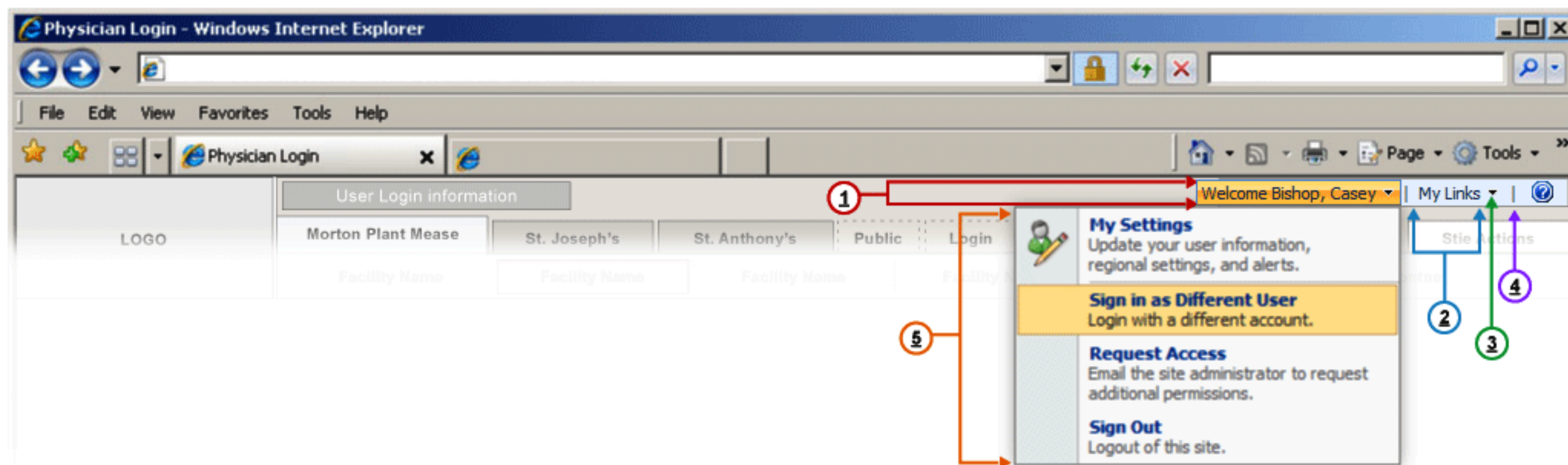

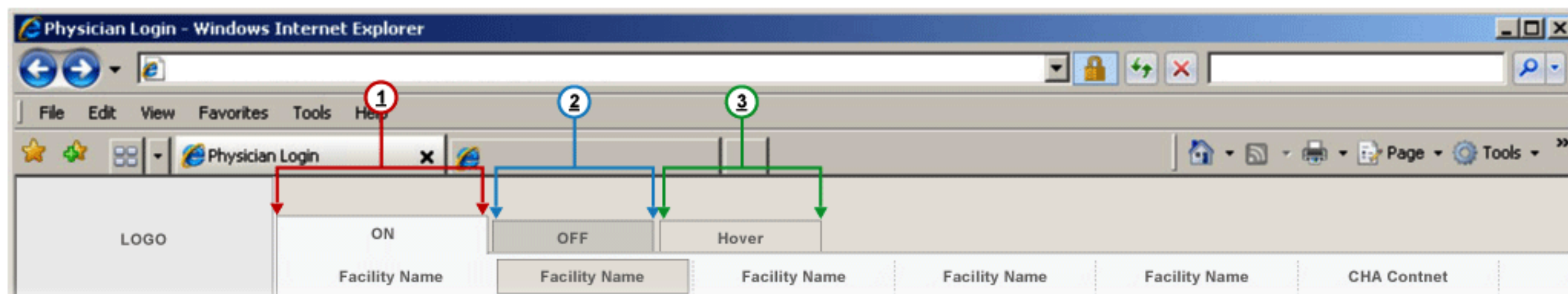

Off State

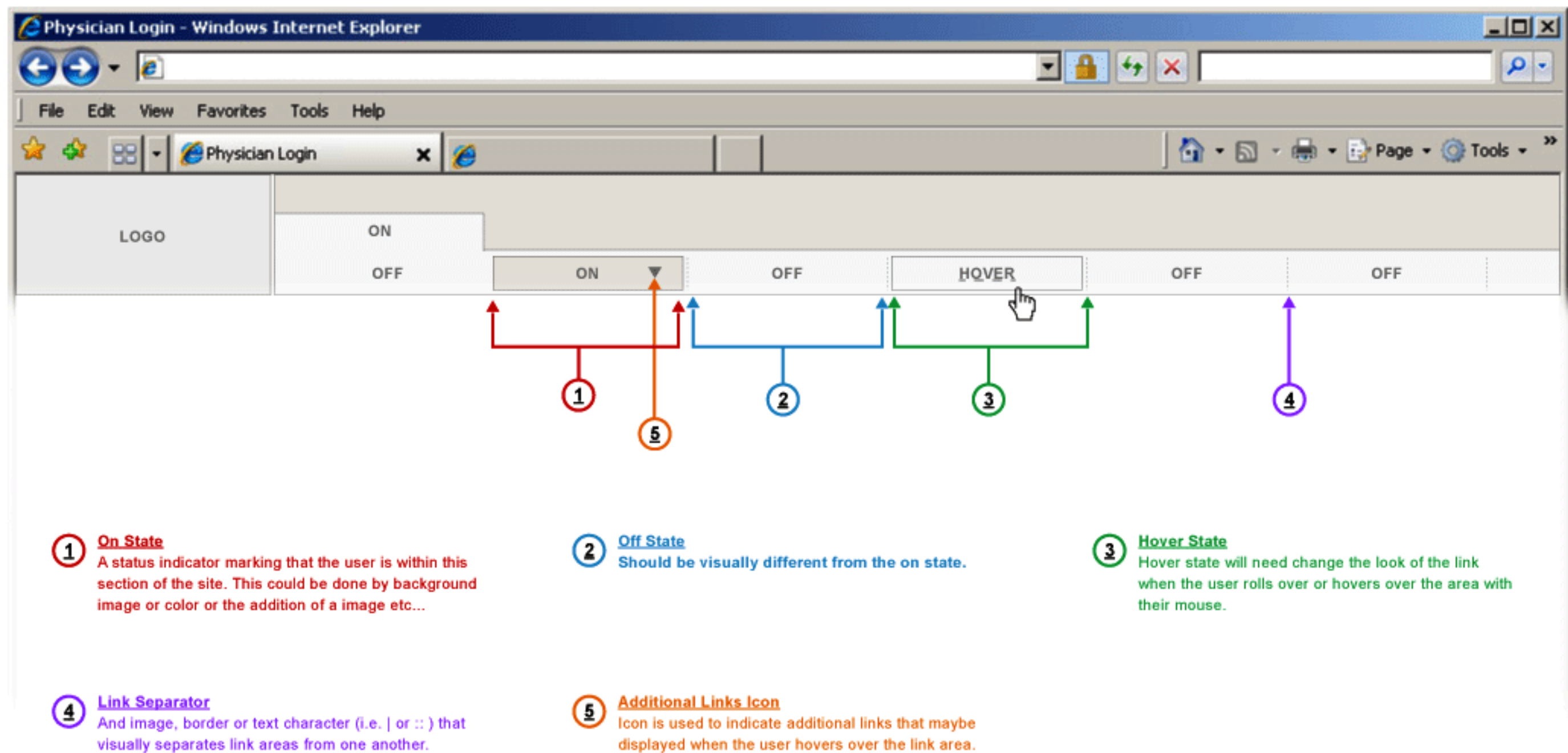
Should be visually secondary to "On" state.

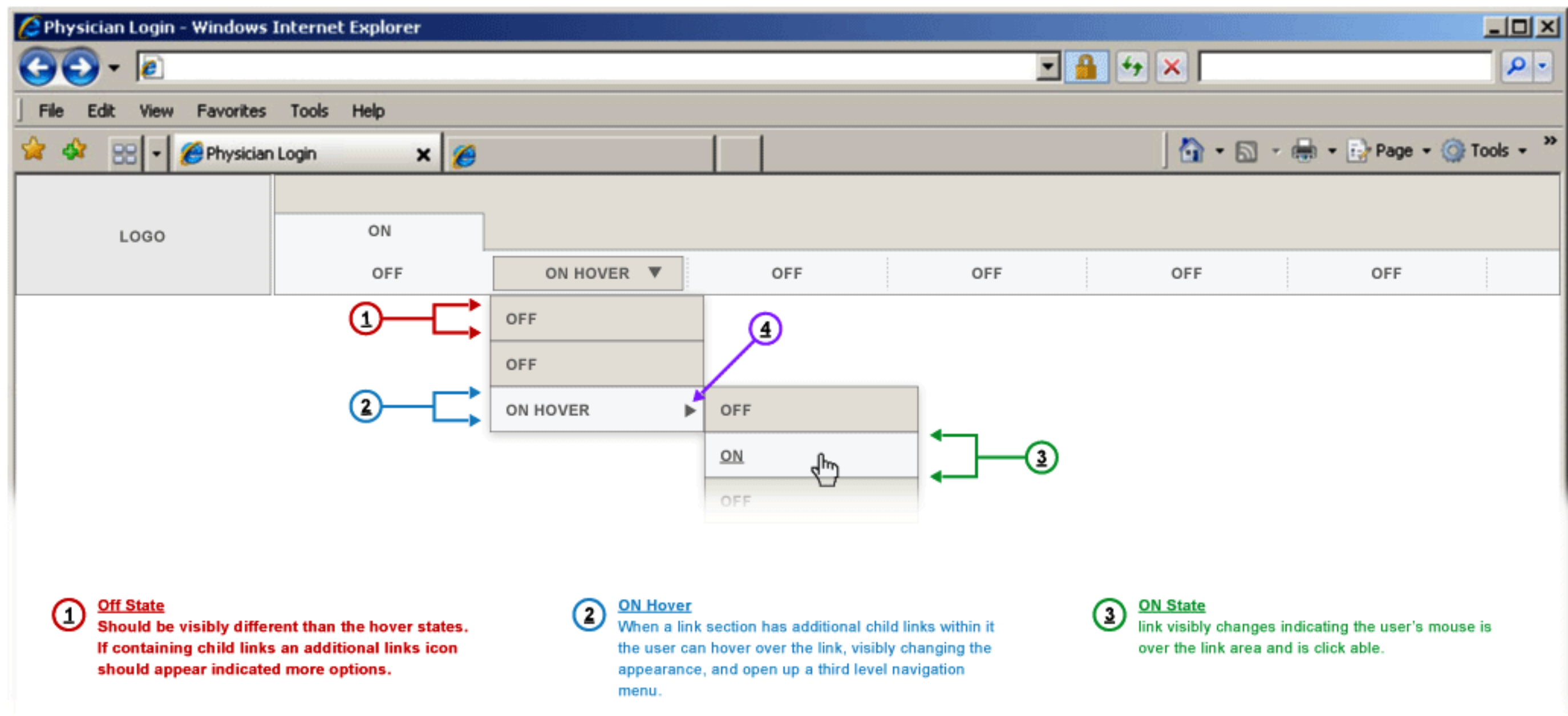
Hover State

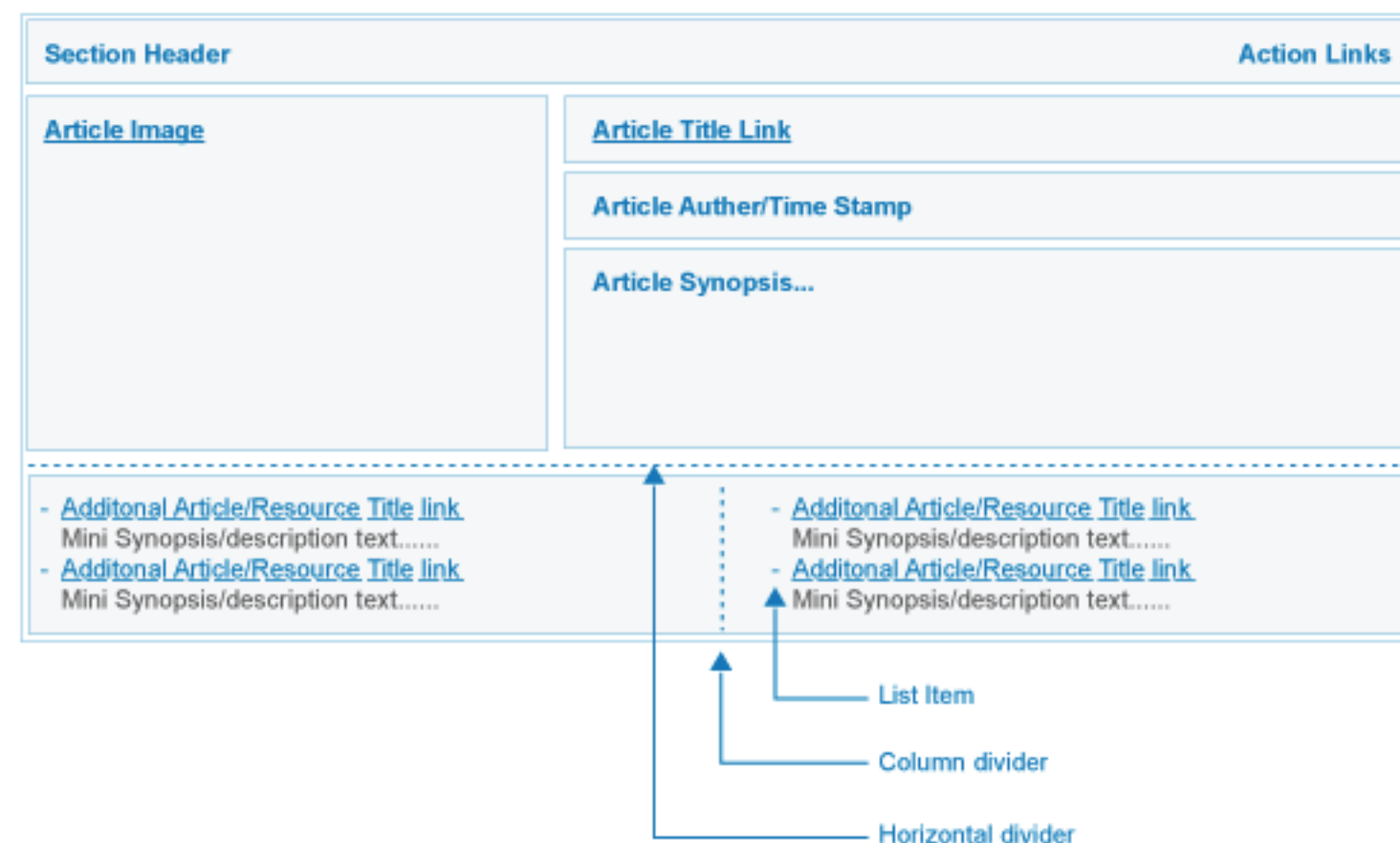
